March 18, 2006

The Board of Regents of the Maine Masonic College assembled at 3:17PM at the Holiday Inn Conference Center in Augusta, Maine following the excellent course presented today by Charles W. Plummer, Ph.D. Present were Bros. Bowden, King, Kuntz, W. Macdougall, McDougal, Nichols, Plummer, Wing, GM Tusch and Chairman George Macdougall along with PGM Wayne Adams.

The minutes of the preceding meeting were accepted as distributed without correction.
